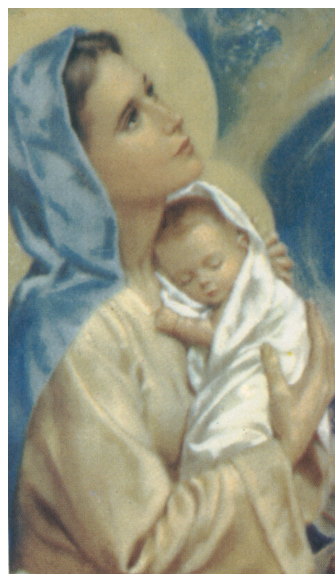

## THE CHRISTMAS CRIB

...will remain up for forty days until Candlemas and the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Candlemas is a gentle feast of light in the darkness of winter. It reminds us of the Light that has entered the world – Jesus Christ, the Son of God – Saviour and Messiah. The entire Christmas Cycle is a crescendo of Christ's manifesting Himself as God and King -- to the shepherds, to the Magi, at His Baptism, to Simeon and the prophetess, Anna. Christmastide liturgically, this year, ends on 9th January, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. But Christmas doesn't end *spiritually* - the celebration of the events of Christ's life as a child don't end, and the great Christmas Cycle doesn't end until February 2.
